AutoCAD LT is the edition targeted at individual users. Both versions of AutoCAD are available on personal computer platforms, with a version for OS X also being available. AutoCAD LT comes with AutoCAD Model Builder, which allows users to create and build DWF (AutoCAD's native data format) files from a schematic or other drawings. Common tasks are supported by user commands, such as using selection tools to select objects, creating new objects, and editing existing objects. What's New in the AutoCAD?

The Markup Import and Markup Assist Extension is designed to automatically import geometric and parametric objects from your CAD software, regardless of your software. To enable automatic import, your CADD software needs to be running (even if the program is not currently open). Each object should be added to the drawing on its own layer. Multiple simultaneous edits can be imported. Automatic import will not work with all CAD applications, so import your drawings into a compatible CAD software to avoid problems. An example of a label inside a circle: When added, the label automatically creates a fitting circle (with center coordinates), or any other custom geometry to fit the object within the circle. This example also includes a clickable, editable link that opens the Text Import dialog. (video: 3:55 min.)
